The High-Tack solvent-based grey adhesive secures good opacity and adhesion on a wide variety of difficult substrates.

The film properties allow application on uneven surfaces and corrugations.

#### **PROCESSING**

Especially designed for solvent based, eco-solvent, mild solvent, Latex and UV inkjet printing on wideformat printing equipment.

To ensure optimal protection and durability, WW 100 Pro needs to be laminated with LF 10700 Series.

To achieve the best possible print quality, please make sure that the correct ICC profiles or printer settings are used.
